

Illness Policy

Created with the goal of supporting the health of all students, families, and staff while providing children the opportunity to explore, socialize, and learn in an engaging outdoor setting.

- Parents/Guardians will keep their child home if the child has had a fever (temperature of 100.4 degrees or greater), vomiting, or diarrhea within 24 hours of class. A no-touch thermometer will be available at Roots if needed. We request children also stay home if they are experiencing notable fatigue, persistent coughing, or excessive nasal drainage.
- Teachers will stay home if they have had a temperature of 100.4 degrees or greater within 24 hours of class.
